A one man show written and performed by **Charlie Ryder**. This true story is told creatively using a variety of theatrical devices including masks, puppetry, physical theatre and dance.

The Theatre: Former prisoner Charlie Ryder did time after an anti-BNP demo in 1993. His performance brings to life his prison scrapbook, and asks 'what does going to prison really entail?'. He puts a face to what is often the 'faceless prisoner', and depicts the dehumanising trauma of day to day prison procedures.

The Debate: After the show Charlie will hold a Q & A session - your opportunity to debate and discuss the issues raised.
